

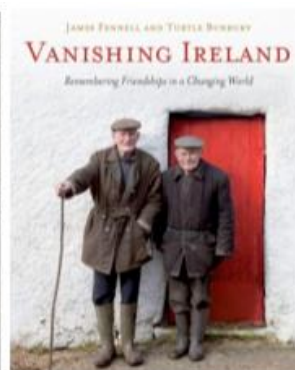
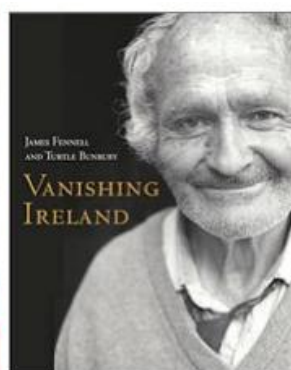
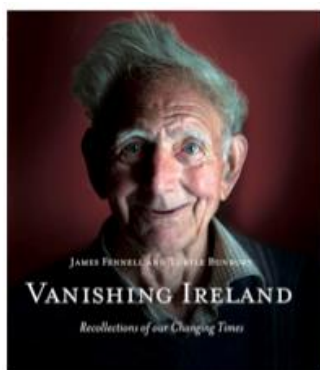
Glenville Park presents **VANISHING IRELAND** by Turtle Bunbury
